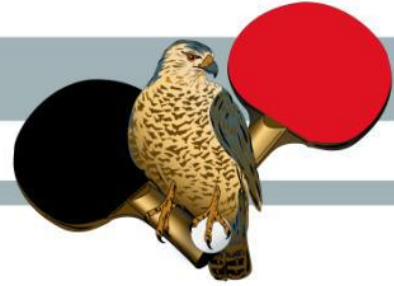

Code of Conduct/Practice for Members

Haworth Hawks is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the well-being of all its members. The club believes that it is important that members (players, coaches, officials, volunteers and parents) associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with Andy Bray, Chairman & Head Coach.

As a member of Haworth Hawks, you are expected to abide by the following:

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all members regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- Not use or tolerate inappropriate or offensive language.
- Not smoke, consume alcohol or take drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
- Wear suitable footwear and clothing for all practice, coaching and match sessions.
- Pay annual club fees and coaching fees promptly.
